Edil San Felice has been awarded a framework agreement worth over €4 million by ASPI for works on protected architectural heritage assets.**The works will involve Palazzo Fagnoni and the Church of San Giovanni Battista, near Florence.**

Naples, 25 June 2026 – Edil San Felice S.p.A. Società Benefit (“the Company” or “Edil San Felice”) – a leading integrated operator active in the maintenance of critical infrastructure in Italy and listed on the Euronext Growth Milan market – has been awarded a Framework Agreement by Autostrade per l’Italia S.p.A. for extraordinary maintenance works on listed buildings managed by its Florence General Directorate.

The Framework Agreement, awarded to the temporary consortium comprising Edil San Felice and Fenix Consorzio Stabile SCARL, has a total value of €4,738,800. Edil San Felice holds a 90.00% share, amounting to €4,264,920.

The contract will run for four years from the date on which the Framework Agreement is signed and will be implemented through subsequent call-off contracts.

Participation in the tender procedure was made possible by the Group’s OG2 certification – relating to protected cultural heritage assets – and by the specialist expertise of Aures, formerly Sogem, a centre of excellence in the restoration and maintenance of properties of historical and architectural significance. Aures joined the Edil San Felice Group in 2023 through a targeted acquisition.

The transaction enabled Edil San Felice to integrate highly specialised expertise in a particularly valuable market segment: the conservation of protected historical and architectural heritage.

The works will involve Palazzo Fagnoni, which is used as office premises, and the Church of San Giovanni Battista in Campi Bisenzio, also known as the “Church of the Autostrada del Sole”.

The activities will include extraordinary maintenance and conservation work on listed buildings and structures, the restoration of façades and architectural features, the restoration of historic window and door frames and high-quality wooden elements, as well as work on roofs, waterproofing, flooring, wall coverings and interior finishes.

The project will also include the refurbishment and upgrading of electrical, water, lighting, air-conditioning, heating and emergency systems.

The works will be carried out in a particularly sensitive environment, both because of the value of the properties involved and the need, where applicable, to ensure the continuity of ordinary activities. The construction sites will therefore be organised with the aim of protecting and enhancing the existing architectural features while minimising any potential disruption to users.

Lorenzo Di Palma, CEO of Edil San Felice, commented: “This contract enables us to leverage specialist expertise that complements our capabilities in the maintenance sector. Our OG2 certification and Aures’s contribution allow us to work on protected assets of particular significance, applying the same organisational, safety and quality standards that characterise our operating model. The Church of San Giovanni Battista is a building of recognised architectural and symbolic value,



dedicated to the memory of the workers who lost their lives during the construction of the Autostrada del Sole. Working on this building and on Palazzo Fagnoni represents an important responsibility for us and provides further confirmation of the relationship of trust we have established with Autostrade per l'Italia.”

Founded in 1979, Edil San Felice is now one of the main operators in motorway maintenance, with a presence across Italy through two operational facilities in Naples and Bologna and a workforce of more than 350 employees.

The Company's main business areas are divided into: (i) road safety services; (ii) maintenance of viaducts and other civil engineering structures; and (iii) other services.
